

AUTHORS INSTRUCTIONS FOR FINAL PAPER SUBMISSION

Provisional V1

The final papers submission deadline is Monday ~~45~~ 29 June 2009.

Only electronic final web submission is possible for the final paper submission, according to the instructions given below.

Authors must use the IEEE Conference eXpress to either convert their final paper into compatible PDFs or to submit their own PDFs for compatibility testing.

Please note that our paper submission system is only able to handle PDF-files up to 2.0 MB (Megabyte).

Writing the final paper

Use of the [RADAR'09 template](#) is mandatory and only final paper following the instructions provided below will be considered.

RADAR'09 paper template:

- **Language:** English
- **Programme:** Microsoft Word 6.0 (or later version)
- **Paper template:** [download the RADAR'09 paper template](#). Do not change font or font-size or leading (line spacing). Keep the size of the page to A4 (21 cm x 29.70 cm) and not Legal (21.59 cm x 27.94 cm). Please pay attention to the **copyright number** included on the first page of the template, at the bottom, left-hand side: leave it in your final paper.
- **Paper title:** The paper abstract title should be centered completely capitalized, and in Times Roman font 16-point, boldface type.
- **Author's identification:** include affiliations of all authors, and full address including e-mail of the corresponding author.
- **Length: Maximum 6 pages** (including figures) . **DO NOT** number your pages.
- **Font:** use Times New Roman font size 10 throughout, except for the title which should be Times New Roman 16 Bold and the abstract which should be Times New Roman 12. **Remember to embed all fonts.** Avoid the use of non-English language fonts.
- **Special characters:** when inserting special characters in text use Insert Symbol (avoid code-numbers for the symbols).
- **Figures:** Insert the figures and/or the tables in the text as 'picture'. File-format of figures should be Jpg (300-600 dpi) or Tiff (up to 1200 dpi)

PDF conversion

Authors must use the IEEE Conference eXpress to either convert their final paper into compatible PDFs or to submit their own PDFs for compatibility testing.

The necessary account will be very soon posted on the conference website.
